Dear John,

The following resolution passed by the Faculty Senate November 16, 1982, is presented for your consideration:

82-70 The Faculty Senate requests the Administration not to record on official student academic records all courses in which a student enrolls but subsequently elects to drop during the first thirty class days of a semester or the first ten days of a summer session term.

In the event that student records already include courses dropped within the thirty-day period, the Faculty Senate further requests that these courses dropped be removed from student official academic records.

When we have assigned a number to all the resolutions approved by the Senate at the November meeting, we will notify your office. Another letter detailing the remaining resolutions will follow shortly.
