> Faculty stipend and tuition rates were discussed. Tuition rates were increased to \$45 per semester hour for undergraduate credit and to \$50 per semester hour for graduate credit. Faculty stipends were increased by 20% beginning fall, 1983.

A campus-wide survey was conducted to determine if departments and schools were interested in offering degree programs during evening hours. Twenty-six units responded to the survey. Seven of the 26 reporting units indicate interest in investigating the possibility of offering sufficient courses for a major during evening hours. Twenty-one of the reporting units indicate an interest in offering more courses during evening hours, even though they may not

be able to offer sufficient courses for a major.
