

FACULTY SENATE MINUTES

April 18, 1984

The organizational meeting of the Faculty Senate for the 1984-85 academic year was held in Room 244, Mendenhall Student Center on Wednesday, April 18, 1984, at 2:10 p.m. with James LeRoy Smith, chair, presiding (except during election of Chair when Stella Daugherty, vice chair, presided). Members absent were: Downing (Theatre Arts), Terrell (Education), Chancellor Howell, Vice Chancellor Laopus. Alternates present were: Givens for Thomas (Allied Health), Haggard for Davis (Math), and Boklage for O'Brien (Medicine).

Agenda Item I. The Chair called the meeting to order and recognized McGee, Grossnickle and Sadler as tellers for the election.
