



SUBJ: Consideration of an amendment to Appendix A of the Faculty Manual at the General Faculty Convocation, Thursday, August 18, 1988, 9:00 a.m.

On April 12, 1988, the East Carolina University Faculty Senate adopted Resolution #88-28, as follows:

STATUS OF THE SENATE PARLIAMENTARIAN
Amendment to Faculty Manual, Appendix A
Sections VII and VIII (Pages A-4 and A-5)

Page A-4: Omit the fourth paragraph under Section VII.

Page A-5: Under Section VIII, first paragraph, add amendment to end of paragraph as follows:

"Before the first regular meeting of the Faculty Senate, the Chair will appoint the Parliamentarian of the Faculty. The Parliamentarian need not be a member of the Faculty Senate, but shall advise the Chair on the parliamentary matters according to the latest edition of Robert's Rules of Order and the Constitution and By-laws of the Faculty Senate."

Page A-5: Strike the last paragraph of Section VIII.

Pursuant to Appendix A, Page A-8, Section XIV. Amendments to the Constitution of the Faculty Senate, this resolution will be considered at the General Faculty Convocation on Thursday, August 18, 1988, 9:00 a.m., Hendrix Theatre.



- 10:02-10:07 General faculty consideration of amendment to Faculty Senate Constitution.
- 10:07 Atkeson announces that the faculty of the College of Arts and Sciences should remain in the theatre and that new faculty will meet at 2:00 in General Classroom Building 1028 (note room change).
