DESCRIPTION OF PROGRAM AND RELATIONSHIP TO INSTITUTIONAL MISSION AND UNIT VISION:

A degree program leading to the dual degrees, MD and Ph.D., is proposed to provide special training and education for a small number of highly selected students who aspire to positions of leadership in academic medicine. This program is consonant with the goals of item #5 in the School of Medicine Unit report. The curriculum is still in the planning stage and is being designed as a 6-7 year track at the minimum. It is considered desirable to seek full funding from extramural sources. Admission procedures and curriculum management will be distinct from those employed for candidates of the MD or Ph.D. degrees alone.

RATIONALE FOR PROGRAM ADDITION/DELETION/REDESIGN:

There is a growing need for physician-scholars in academic medicine. The proposed program responds to this need and to an implicit obligation of schools of medicine for the training of physicians for leadership in medicine. It is estimated that no more than one or two candidates a year will enroll in this rigorous program.
