Professors Bernhardt, Schellenberger, and Zincone requested approval for MATH 1066, Applied Math for Decision Making, thereby changing the General Education requirement, BSBA, BS ACCT, and prerequisite for Math 2283. Wease moved approval as amended; Wilentz seconded. The motion passed.

Professor Frank requested approval for MUSIC 5757, Lute and Guitar Literature, and to unbank 2248, Music of the World's Peoples. Topper moved approval; Wease seconded. The motion passed.

GENERAL EDUCATION REQUIREMENTS FOR ALL BACCALAUREATE DEGREE PROGRAMS

Mathematics

Three hours of mathematics at least equivalent to MATH 1065 or MATH 1066 or MATH 2127,...

Page 129, add

MATH 1066. Applied Mathematics for Decision Making (3)

Prerequisite: Appropriate score on the MATH pre-test or approval of the Chair of the Mathematics Department.

Required for students planning to major in Business Administration or Accounting. Skills in formulating models for and interpreting solutions to business word problems will be developed. Topics covered: linear equations, non-linear equations, systems of linear equations, applications of matrix algebra, and applied basic differential calculus (no proofs will be included). Course will satisfy the general education mathematics requirement.
