## SEVENTH ANNUAL INTERCOLLEGIATE ATHLETIC REPORT

The seventh annual report of the fifteen constituent institutions participating in intercollegiate athletics is present in the following four summary tables.

Table 1 presents graduation data for students entering in 1983 through 1987. The rates shown are for students graduating within five years from the institution in which they enrolled. This table presents the results for all students, for student-athletes, and for athletes playing football and men's basketball. The data clearly show that athletes at each institution perform almost as well as, if not better than, the overall student body.

Table 2 shows trends in the admission of freshman athletes as "exceptions" for football and men's basketball from 1986 through 1992. Within this context, it is important to note that each constituent institution defines "exceptions" according to its own admissions standards. As in 1991, no student-athletes were admitted in 1992 who failed to meet the minimum admissions requirements established by the Board of Governors.

Table 3 indicates trends in the admission of freshman "exceptions" for all freshmen and those recruited as student athletes for the fall of 1991 and 1992. This table gives a comprehensive view of "exceptions" as applied to all students in general and student-athletes in particular.

Table 4 provides SAT scores for the 1990, 1991, and 1992, freshmen recruited to play football and men's basketball. A comparison of the data for this period shows fewer student-athletes scoring below 700; however, there was a significant increase in the number of student athletes scoring in the 700's. The number of student athletes scoring in the 800's and 900's, has been approximately the same for this three year period, however, there was a slight decrease in the number of student athletes scoring above 1000 in 1992.
