**NOMINATING COMMITTEE FOR FACULTY OFFICERS REPORT**

Candidates for Chair of the Faculty:

**Patricia Anderson, School of Education**

I am pleased to be nominated as a candidate for the position of Chair of the East Carolina Faculty. Having served two years in the Senate and one term as an alternate, I have gained both perspective and respect for the complex issues and deliberations of our faculty governing body and its standing committees. As a candidate for this office, I applaud ECU's strong commitment and practice of shared faculty governance and would work both to maintain and to promote that sound practice. These goals would be accomplished with committee activities, broad based faculty participation, and the development of Senate agendas which ensure that a wide spectrum of concerns are addressed through the body. My strengths are in listening to identify problems, generating solutions, and taking thoughtful action to directly address faculty concerns. I am willing to serve as an advocate for ECU faculty with administrators, Board of Trustees members, Faculty Assembly, students and other groups. Highlights of my involvement in faculty governance include two years of service as Vice Chair of the Faculty, service on Admissions and Recruitment Committee (including Chair), membership on Educational Policies and Planning Committee, Faculty Affairs Committee, Readmission Appeals Committee, Course Drop Appeals Committee, Teaching Effectiveness Committee, Academic Integrity Board, and numerous unit and departmental committees. My research efforts have centered on the process of listening and teacher education, and my teaching effectiveness has been recognized by the 1985 Robert and Lina Worthington Mays Alumni Award. These responsibilities have afforded me the opportunity to develop leadership skills and insight into the unique importance of the university, the interdependence of its units, and the necessity for a strong and active faculty. If elected, I would accept the responsibilities of the position of Chair of the Faculty and would serve with dedication, professionalism and integrity.

**Conner Atkeson, Department of History**

At the heart of every great university there lies a vision shared by the faculty and the administration. The tangible evidence of this vision at East Carolina University is found in the established principles of shared governance set forth in the policies and procedures as recorded in the Faculty Manual. My many years of service on such committees as Faculty Governance and Faculty Affairs and as Chair of the Faculty has given me the opportunity to participate in the redrawing of appendices A, D, and L, documents critical to shared governance. Being a member of grievance committees has also afforded me insights into the concerns of the faculty. My commitment to shared governance has been demonstrated to this Senate and the faculty at large over the years. I see the coming years as ones of challenge to this concept of governance and I believe that my service has given me the understanding to provide the leadership to meet this challenge.

**Tom Chenier, School of Allied Health Sciences**

The Faculty Senate has dealt with a number of issues of the past year, but a number of important issues remain. As we move forward in dealing with these issues, I believe I have a unique combination of experiences to offer in seeking the position of Chair of the Faculty. I have been a faculty member at ECU since 1986 and have served in the Faculty Senate for the past three years. I have served on a number of Academic or Senate committees, having been Chair of the Research/Creative Activity and Senate Agenda Committees. Those of you who have served with me know that I speak my mind frankly on any issue.

I have also had the opportunity to serve as an administrator in my role as Acting Chair of the Department of Biostatistics. I would relinquish that role if I were elected to this position, but the experience would aid me greatly in acting as a liaison between the faculty and the administration. Lastly, if elected, I believe I would be the first alumnus of this university to serve in the position of Faculty Chair.

Candidates for Vice Chair of the Faculty:

**Marie Farr, Department of English**

Serving on and twice chairing the Teaching Effectiveness Committee began my experience with the concept of shared governance in the Faculty Senate, a concept I believe in strongly. I also served on the Appellate Hearing Committee. Following that I held several administrative positions, most recently that of Director of Women's Studies, which confirmed my belief in cooperative effort. I am currently serving my first term as Faculty Senator. What I value most about the Senate is its commitment to balancing faculty needs with those of the university as a whole, including minority constituencies. What I admire most is the humor which frequently leavens sometimes doughy (and doughty!) discussion. And what I desire most is the opportunity to help the Senate provide a faculty voice in the resolution of issues which will determine the identity of ECU in the twenty-first century. (I also promise to continue to serve as unofficial document editor whenever called upon.)

**Jack Karns, School of Business**

I joined the faculty of East Carolina University in 1986 and am in my eleventh year of full-time teaching. I am also serving my second, non-consecutive term in the Faculty Senate. As to other service commitments, I have served as Secretary of the Faculty Senate Agenda Committee (1989-90), as a member of the University Libraries Committee (1988-90), and as a member of the University Hearing Committee (1993) elected by the Faculty Senate to fill a temporary vacancy. I have also been active within the School of Business having served as a member of the School-wide Nominating Committee (1988-90), as Chair of the Department of Finance Personnel Committee (1988-90; 1992-94).*\** As the Faculty Representative I serve as a direct link between the School of Business faculty and the Dean. I also work with local legal services organizations to provide pro bono representation to indigents, and assist civic and charitable organizations seeking to achieve tax exempt status under the Internal Revenue Code.

**Brian McMillen, School of Medicine**

I joined the faculty of East Carolina University in 1982. Since that time, I have been an active member of many campus and school committees. The Faculty Senate committees I have served on includes: Libraries Committee (Secretary, '88-'91), Research/Creative Activity Committee (Chair, '86-'87), Educational Policies and Planning Committee, and currently Reconsideration Committee, and Faculty Welfare Committee. In addition, I chaired the Ad-Hoc Committee for Research/Creative Activity Policy and Guidelines which developed Appendix U of the Faculty Manual (and I am currently rewriting the procedural sections of this appendix). Within the School of Medicine, I am Chair of the Graduate Studies Committee and a member of the Admissions Committee. Also, I serve as Coordinator for Graduate Studies for the Department of Pharmacology. As part of my campus wide interests, I served on master student thesis committees for the Departments of Biology, Chemistry, Psychology and the School of Human Environmental Sciences. Last year ('92-'93) was my first year as an Alternate Senator and I was elected this year as a Senator to represent the School of Medicine. It is with this broad cross-campus background, that I hope to aid Faculty Senate deliberations and assist the next Chair of the Faculty. With this extensive experience, I believe that I will be an effective Vice Chair of the Faculty and more than just a voice for one school.

Candidates for Secretary of the Faculty:
