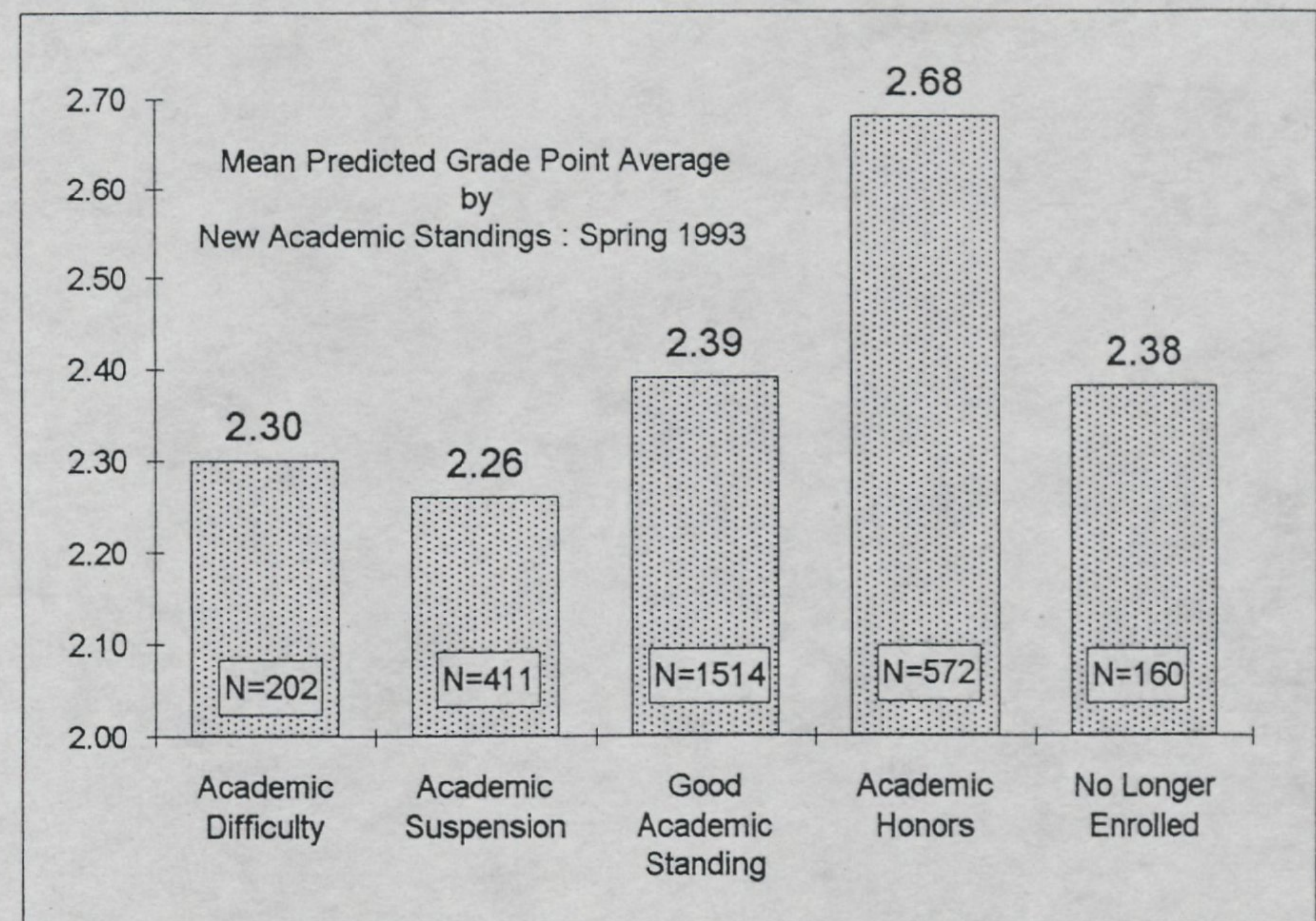
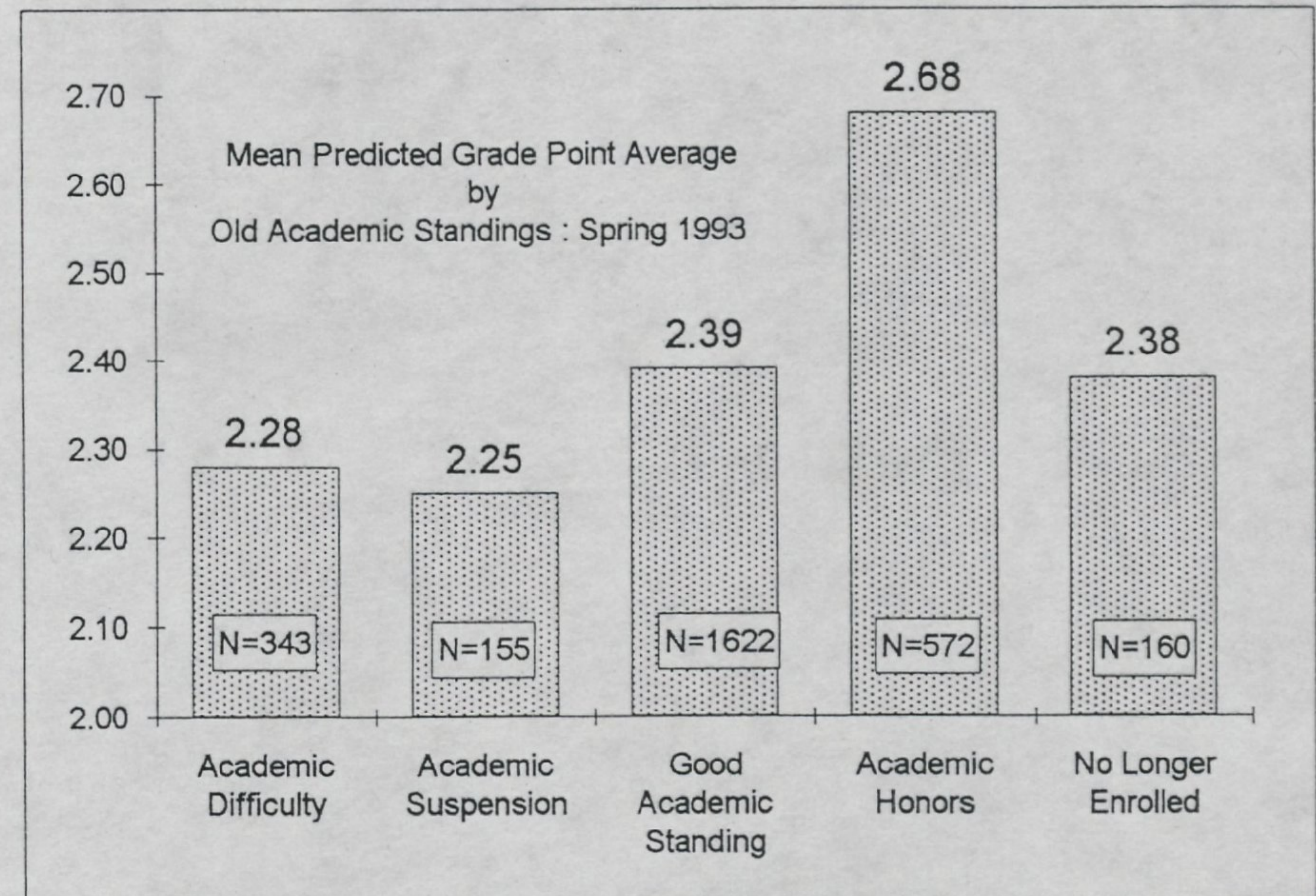
Academic Standing of First-Time, Full-Time Freshman Cohorts
after Completing Two Semesters



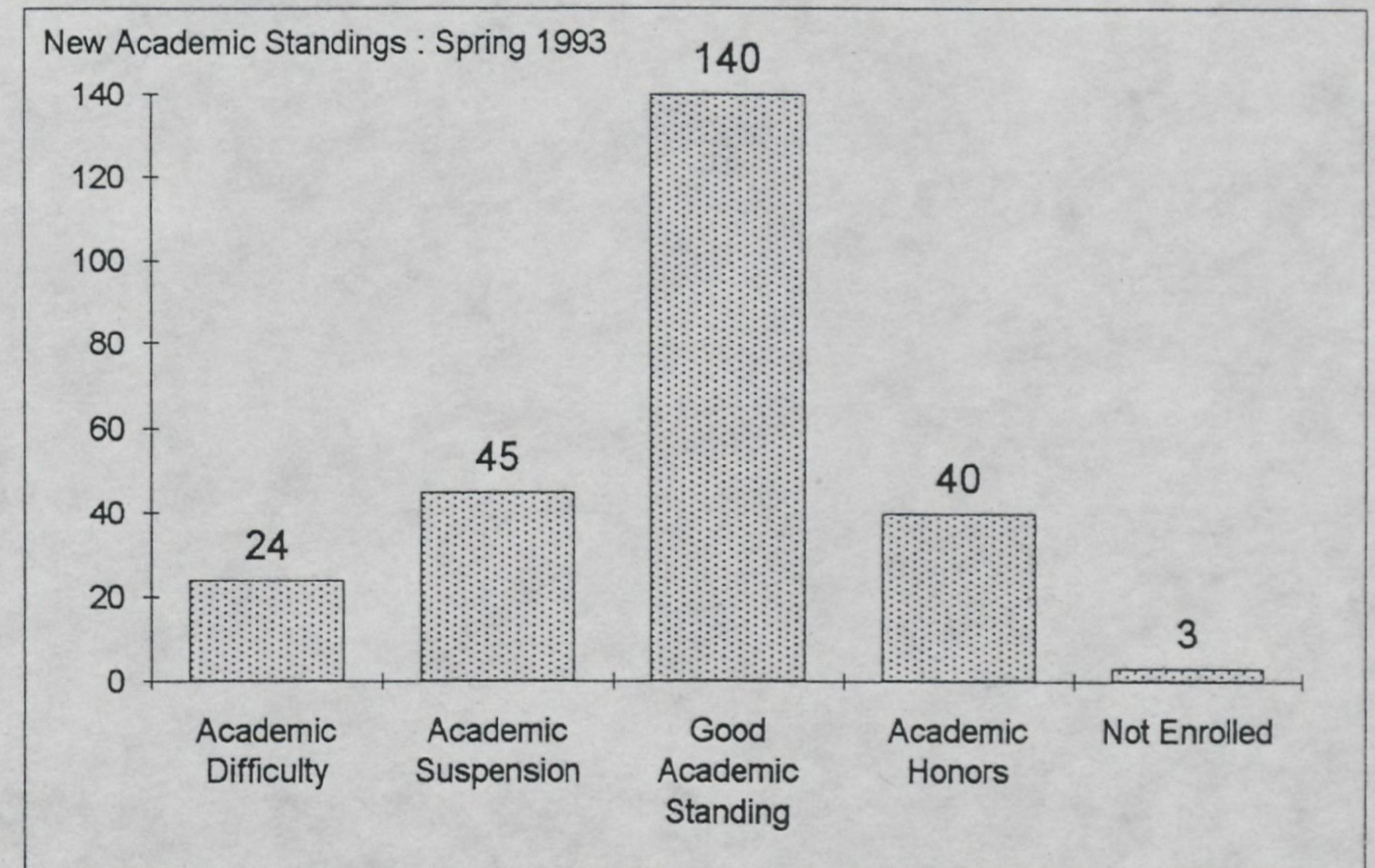
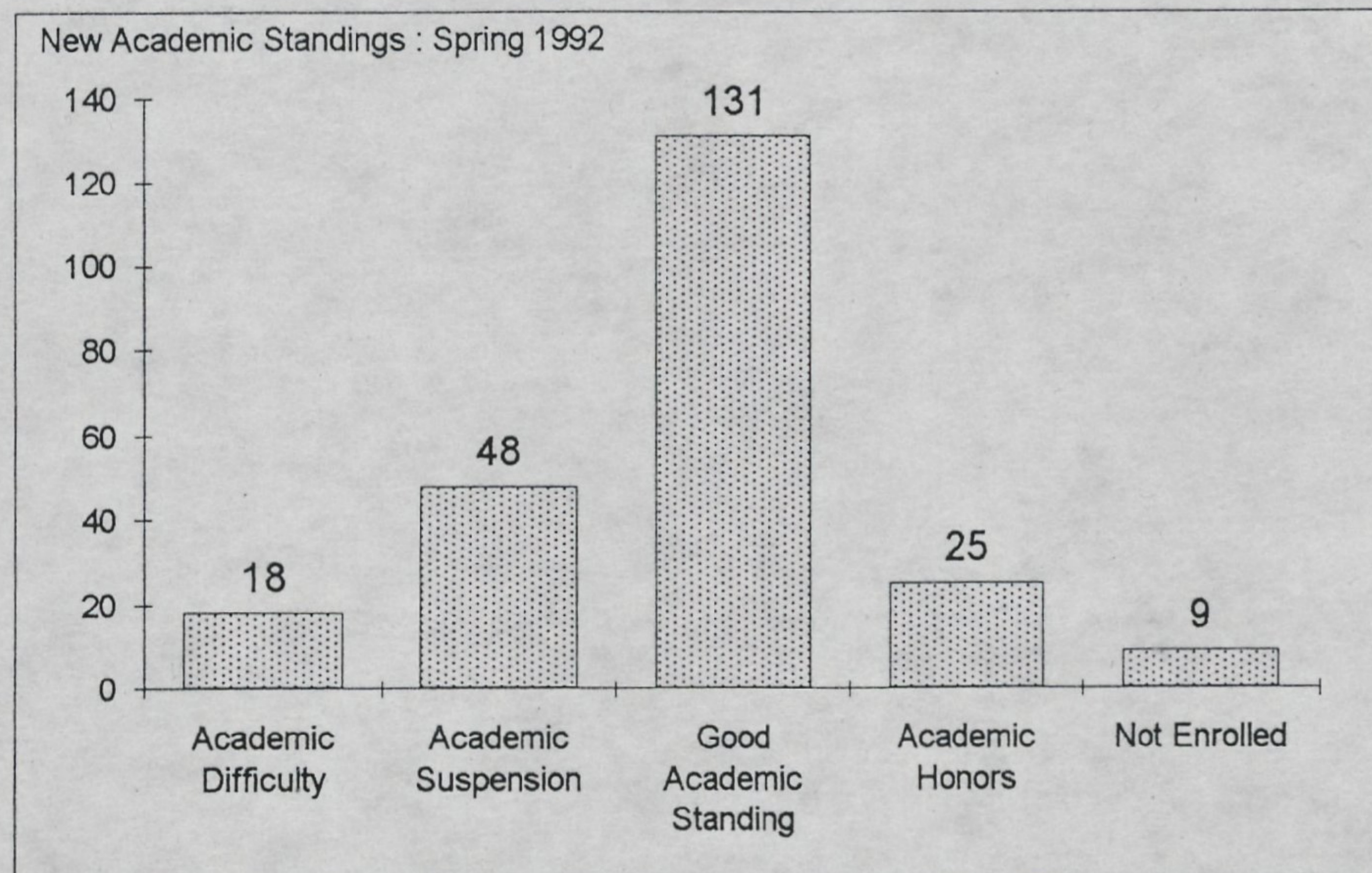
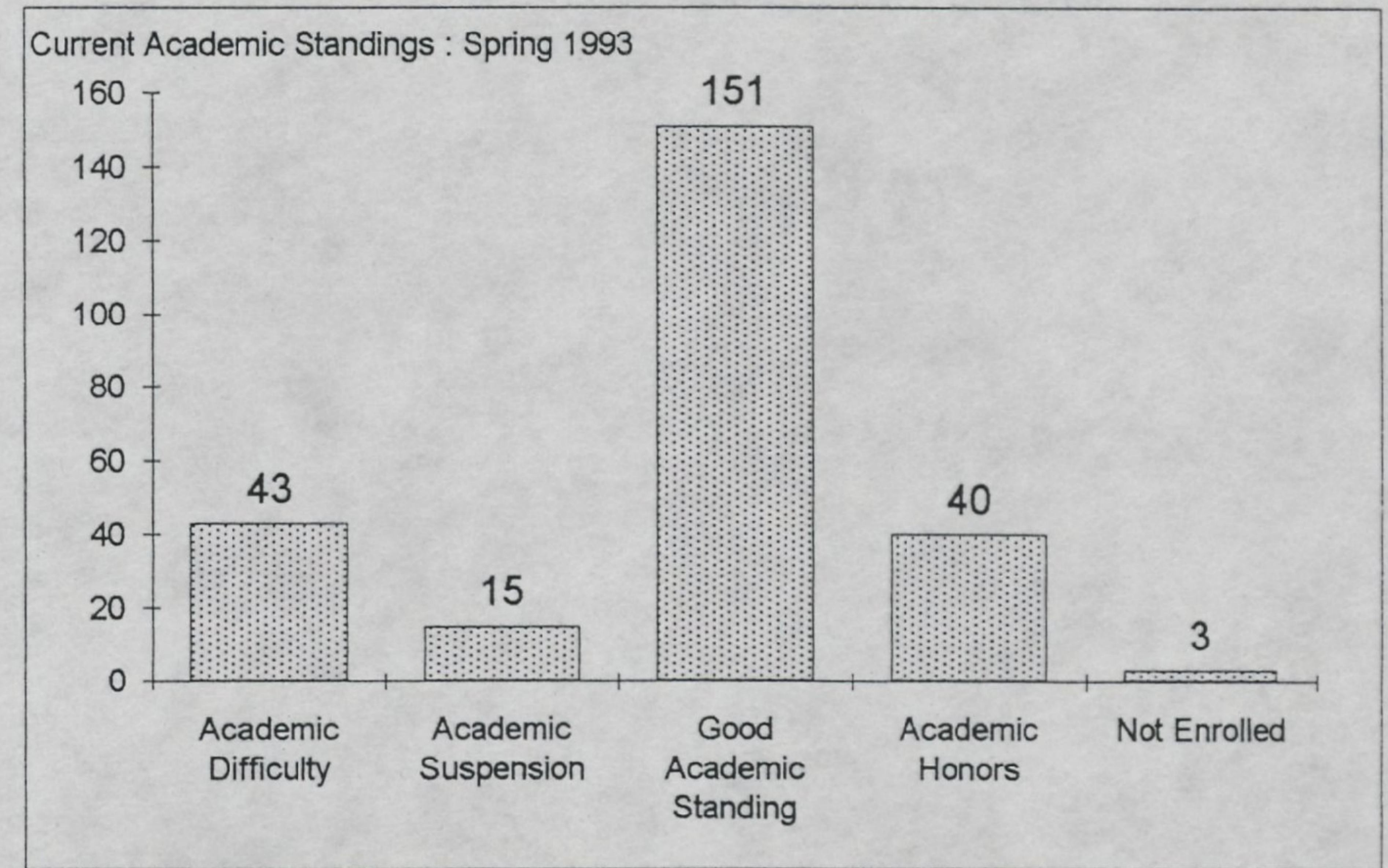
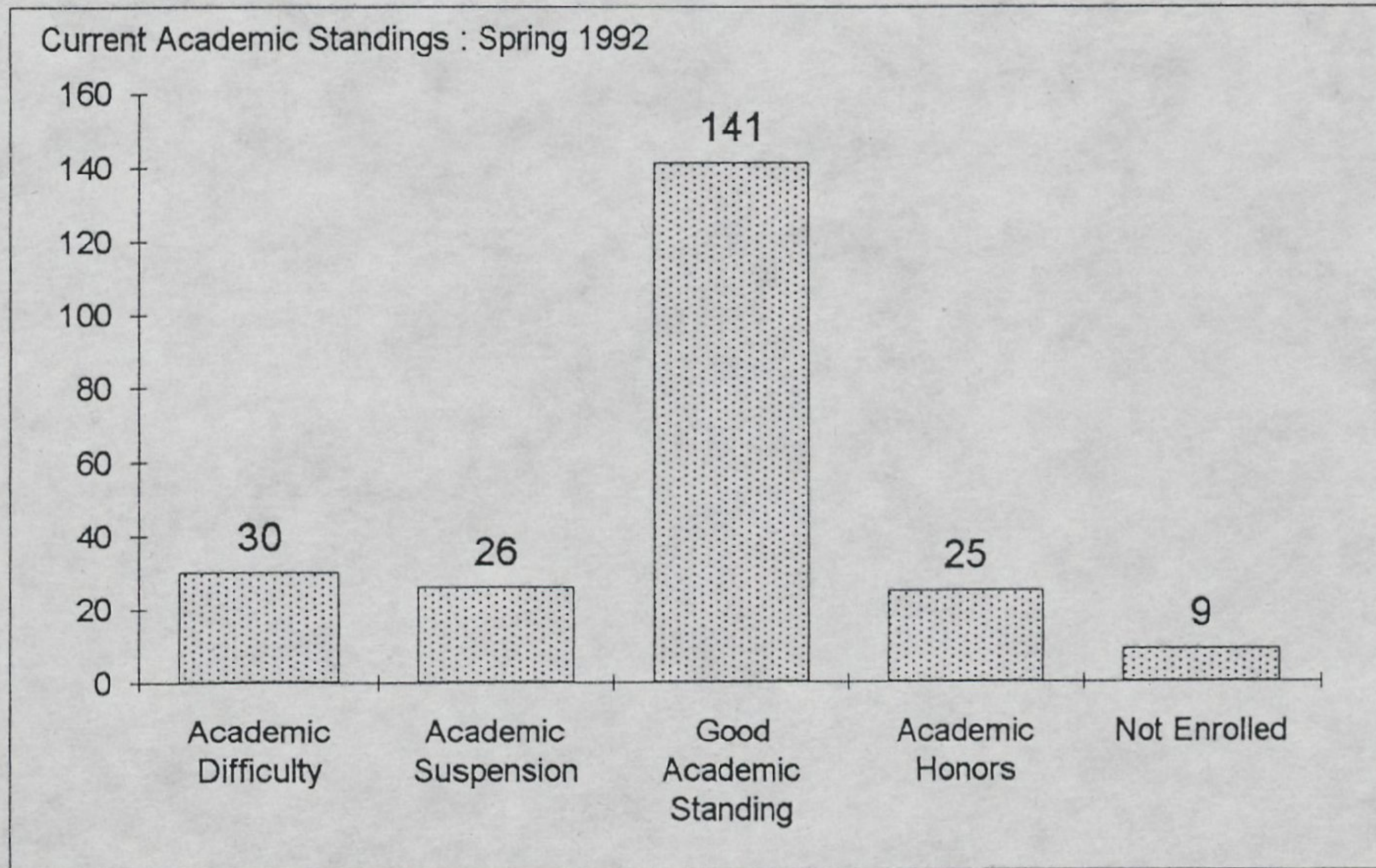
Members of the Fall 1991 Cohort
