INDEX OF CUNNINGHAMS

Many Cunninghams who came to this country early in its history have been forgotten. As the years pass the number of forgotten ones increases.

The purpose of this project is to preserve the names and identities of all Cunninghams who have lived in America.

The problems involved are: To find and identify the names of Cunninghams - both of the past and the present, and to compile these names into a form that can be given wide distribution.

Our procedure in solving the problems and thereby accomplishing the purpose of this project will include:

Seeking cooperation from all Cunninghams through advertisements in nation-wide genealogical periodicals and through correspondence and interviews.

Compiling the information contributed into an INDEX and copy onto stencils and mimeograph. No interpretation will be made - it will be copied as received.

Assembling the sheets into a cumulative, loose-leaf book. Revised sheets will be issued as additional names and identifying data are received.

Notifying libraries that the INDEX is available at the cost of mimeograph supplies and mailing. (All work involved in the project is to be done by volunteers without charge.)

JOSEPH CUNNINGHAM, YOEMAN

received proprietary patent for 168 acres of land from Thomas and Richard Penn, Esquires (sons of William Penn), in 1765. This land was situate in Earl Township, Lancaster County, Penn. The same year he deeded twenty-seven and two quarter acres of the tract to his eldest son, James. Soon after, Joseph died intestate and James petitioned the Orphans Court of Lancaster County to have his father's land viewed and evaluated. The viewers were of the opinion that Joseph's land could not be divided without "injury and spoiling the whole" and James received a deed from each of the other children for their share in their father's estate. At the time of the settlement of his estate (1769-1770) Joseph's children were:
