WHEREAS, two East Carolina University Professors, Dr. James Leroy Smith and Dr. Ernest Uhr, were applicants for the position, each of whom has outstanding academic credentials, adminstrative experience, and distinguished record of service at East Carolina University; and

WHEREAS, the qualifications of the two in-house applicants compare favorably with those of the four finalist candidates selected by the Search Committee; and

WHEREAS, the choice for the position of Vice Chancellor for Academic Affairs of an in-house candidate who possesses an intimate knowledge and understanding of East Carolina University's present and past would bring with it the opportunity for a smooth and efficient transition process which could result in a more efficient continuity of University activities;

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED,

That the Search Committee for Vice Chancellor of Academic Affairs and Chancellor Richard Eakin consider the two in-house applicants, Dr. James Leroy Smith and Dr. Ernest Uhr, as <u>finalist</u> candidates for said position and that these two candidates be accorded treatment and consideration identical to all other candidates.
