

SUBJECT: Faculty Computer Program funding

A question was raised at the November Senate meeting about the pattern of funding for the Faculty Computer Program over the past several years. The annual base funding for the program has been approximately \$100,000. More was available for allocation in 1993-94 and 1994-95, but budget reductions dictated by enrollment downturns limited the amount available for 1995-96. Increases in per unit cost (and resulting decreases in the number of units awarded) reflect the need to place more high-end, sophisticated (and expensive) computers in the hands of award recipients.


