

CERTIFICATE OF SCHOLARSHIP
IN
RANDOLPH MACON COLLEGE.

This is to Certify, That Mr. Luke S. Clammy of New Hanover — and State of N. Carolina having paid to the Trustees of Randolph Macon College the sum of Two Hundred Dollars, is hereby entitled to a Scholarship in said College. This Scholarship confers on him the privilege of having all his Sons—those now in being, and those that may hereafter be born—instructed in the Schools of said College, free from all tuition fees and charges for room rent—each Son being entitled to the privilege of a regular course of instruction, for the term of two years in the Preparatory Department, and four years ~~in~~ the College proper; and having all the rights and privileges of other Students, and being subject to the same regulations and discipline, and no more; nor will the privileges hereby conferred on the Sons, be defeated by the death of the Father in their minority. And if the said Luke S. Clammy shall have no Son which he may wish to enter in either of said Schools, then he is authorized, at all times during his life, to have one Student of his own selection in the Preparatory School or in the College proper, as aforesaid. But this Certificate of Scholarship; and the rights which it confers, are in no event assignable or transferable.
