# ELECTION OF FACULTY OFFICERS 

Candidate for Chair of the Faculty


#### Abstract

Donald Sexauer, School of Art Donald Sexauer has been a member of the faculty since 1960. He has served on a number of academic and appellate committees including the Faculty Governance committee, the Unit Code Screening committees, the Hearing Committee and the Reconsideration Committee. He has served on a number of ad hoc committees including the committee to screen unit codes, the committee to revise Appendix C and the committee to rewrite Appendix D. During this past academic year Professor Sexauer has served as the chair of the faculty. In this position Professor Sexauer is responsible for all the duties of the chair as described in Appendix A, Section VIIII of the Faculty Manual. In his capacity as chair of the faculty, Professor Sexauer has served as an ex-officio member of the Faculty Governance Committee, the Committee on Committees, and the Educational Policies and Planning Committee. Along with the regular duties of the office he has written bimonthly articles for the Pieces of Eight, created a home page for the Faculty Senate, and added the proper HTML code to the Faculty Manual and installed it on the World Wide Web. In his capacity as chair of the faculty he has served as a member of the Administrative Information Resources Coordinating Council during this academic year. In this position he has been an advocate for promoting the development of a training center that will allow faculty to become familiar with the new teaching technologies. Professor Sexauer would like to see the training center for faculty become a reality.


Candidates for Vice Chair of the Faculty

## Wes Hankins, School of Industry and Technology

In 1968 I joined the faculty of the Department of Geography. Since that time I have served as the chair of the following committees: Physical Plant Committee: ECU Self-Study, Educational Policies and Planning Committee, Campus Facilities Planning and Development Committee, Traffic Regulations Revision Committee, and University Facilities Committee. In the mid-1970's I held the position of Head Coach of the ECU Men's Tennis Team. I was a member of the Athletic Self-Study Task Force in 1980 and the Campus Beautification Committee in 1987. I am currently serving on the University Athletics Committee. I completed two terms as a Faculty Senate Alternate and one term as a Senator while a faculty member within the Department of Geography and Planning. I am completing my first term as a Senator in the School of Industry and Technology. I have served as Chair of both the Greenville Planning and Zoning Commission and the Subdivision Review Committee. I believe my broad background has prepared me for service as Vice Chair of the Faculty. If elected to this position, I will fulfill the duties of the office with an emphasis on faculty governance, representing all elements of the University community, and a commitment to the University's strategic planning process.

Brenda Killingsworth, School of Business
It has been a pleasure serving as Vice Chair of the Faculty during this academic year. Since joining the faculty of East Carolina University in 1987, I have served six years in the Faculty Senate and nine years on numerous standing and ad hoc University Committees. My experiences have provided me with a broad, campus-wide perspective of the issues facing faculty governance.
