**NOMINATING COMMITTEE FOR FACULTY OFFICERS REPORT
ELECTION OF FACULTY OFFICERS**

Candidate for Chair of the Faculty

Bob Morrison, Department of Chemistry

During the last 30 years it's been fun watching ECU grow in size and stature. It's been a great place for me to teach and learn and do scholarly work. If it is to be an even greater place, we need to protect and maintain our core values for the next generation. The first Faculty Senate committee I served on was the Credits Committee in the early 1970's. Since then I have served on numerous Faculty Senate committees, administrative committees, and task forces along with 3 terms on the Faculty Senate in the 80's. I served as chair of several of these committees. I began another term on the Faculty Senate in the late 90's before becoming parliamentarian and then vice chair. Currently I am serving as ex officio or regular member on 10 Faculty Senate or Administrative Committees, and serve as one of your representatives on the UNC Faculty Assembly. I was recently elected to chair the Academic Freedom and Tenure committee at the Faculty Assembly, and I am a member of a UNC system-wide committee to study fixed-term faculty appointments. I have published 40 scientific articles and have been director or co-director of grants totaling about 1.3 million dollars. We face many challenges to the core values embodied in our collegiality as a community of scholars, in our shared governance, and in our academic authority. If elected Chair of the Faculty I will do my best to keep vigilant watch over our core values.

Candidates for Vice Chair of the Faculty

John Cope, Department of Psychology

I have been at ECU since 1981 and currently holds the rank of professor in the Psychology Department within the College of Arts and Sciences. I am an Industrial Psychologist who specializes in the application of behavioral technology to large scale organizational problem solving. My research has been in the area of traffic safety (promoting seat belt use, and preventing illegal parking in spaces reserved for individuals with disabilities), selection and retention of disabled workers through supported employment, and law enforcement recruiting and selection. I provide industrial consulting in the area of recruiting and selection, job analysis, and management development. I have chaired the Admission and Recruitment Committee for five years, served on the Enrollment Management Council, and currently represent the Chair of the Faculty on the Parking and Traffic Committee. I have been an Alternate and am currently as Senator for the Department of Psychology. I serve as the leader of a 4-H equestrian club, belong to the North Carolina Quarter Horse Association, and served for three years as the chair of a Catholic High School Development Group.

Jack Karns, School of Business

I joined the ECU faculty in 1986 and am presently a tenured professor of business law in the School of Business. I served as chair of the University Hearing Committee for approximately four years, as chair of my Departmental Personnel Committee for ten years and as a member of the University Libraries Committee. From 1993 to 1995 I also served as Vice Chair of the Faculty, a position I now seek again following a hiatus from University governance to focus on my research and writing agenda. Based on twenty years of service in academe, I pledge my efforts as faculty spokesperson, facilitator and consensus builder to insure that East Carolina University remains a respected institution of higher learning, and which continues to draw North Carolina's finest students. Further, I commit my time and service to you and our constituents, our colleagues, to the extent of insuring that they are satisfied that we take their problems and concerns seriously, and will do all within our power to achieve a reasonable result or explanation. This is the foundation of the shared governance system, and I ask for your vote in order to have another opportunity to serve as Vice Chair of the Faculty.

Ralph Scott, Academic Library Services

East Carolina University has had a long tradition of shared governance between the administration, students, staff and faculty. The faculty have had a voice since 1907 in the shaping of a dynamic university that is constantly growing in size and scope. When I came to East Carolina some 30 years I was impressed with the open debate and input the faculty shared with all who would listen. Let us continue this tradition that has made us a leader in this area in North Carolina into the future. I have served as a Faculty Senator, and on: the Agenda Committee, Continuing Education Committee, Faculty Computer Committee, Course Drop Appeals Committee, Readmissions Appeals Committee, Unit Code Screen Committee, Due Process Committee, Governance Committee, Committee on Committees, Parking Citation Appeals Committee, Commencement Committee, Minority Affairs Committee and Academic Integrity Board. I have been an officer of a number of these committees. I have served multiple terms on a number of these committees. I would be honored to serve you now as Vice Chair of the Faculty.

Candidates for Secretary of the Faculty

Mark Jones, School of Social Work and Criminal Justice Studies

I appreciate the Nominating Committee's consideration for re-election as Secretary of the Faculty for the next academic year. I am completing my seventh year as a Criminal Justice Professor within the School of Social Work and Criminal Justice Studies. Prior to assuming my current position as Secretary, I served as Faculty Senator for three years. Throughout my tenure as Secretary and Senator, I have tried to represent the best interests of the entire ECU faculty. I have a good working knowledge of Faculty Senate procedures, which is essential for any Senate officer. For the past three academic years, including the current year, I have served on the Faculty Senate Agenda Committee. Professor Killingsworth has invited me, and I have accepted, to assist the SACS self-study Educational Program Committee. The position of Secretary requires attention to detail. I have served in similar administrative positions in professional and academic criminal justice organizations, including the American Probation and Parole Association, the American Society of Criminology, the Southern Criminal Justice Association, and the Southwestern Association of Criminal Justice Educators. The Secretarial position requires more than the duties we see performed at Senate meetings, i.e., the roll call and recording of minutes. Every Senate officer, regardless of title or function, is a highly visible representative of East Carolina University. I have developed a good working relationship with Chancellor Eakin and the Vice Chancellors during our monthly meetings. I have enjoyed serving as Secretary for the 1999-2000 year, and I will continue to do my best to represent ECU and the academic profession in an honorable and professional manner if re-elected to serve for the 2000-2001 academic year. Thank you for your consideration.

Ginger Woodard, School of Human Environmental Sciences

I am completing my seventh year at ECU and am currently Associate Professor of Merchandising in the Department of Apparel, Merchandising, & Interior Design. I also am serving as Interim Director of Undergraduate Studies for HESC. This completes my first year as a Faculty Senator. Since coming to ECU I have been active in the school serving on the Faculty Development Committee for five years and as Chair for four of those years. I have also served on the school code committee and as an advisor to the student organization. This year I served on the HESC Dean Search Committee and was appointed executive assistant to the chair of the committee by the VCAA. Each of these positions required organizational skills and attention to detail. My professional service includes membership on several committees including the International Textile and Apparel Association where I am currently the VP of Education and a member of the Executive Council. I also am serving as track chair for the American Collegiate Retailing Association annual meeting and am the department liaison for the National Retailing Federation. I am committed to my profession and ECU. I would consider it an honor to be Secretary of the Faculty.
