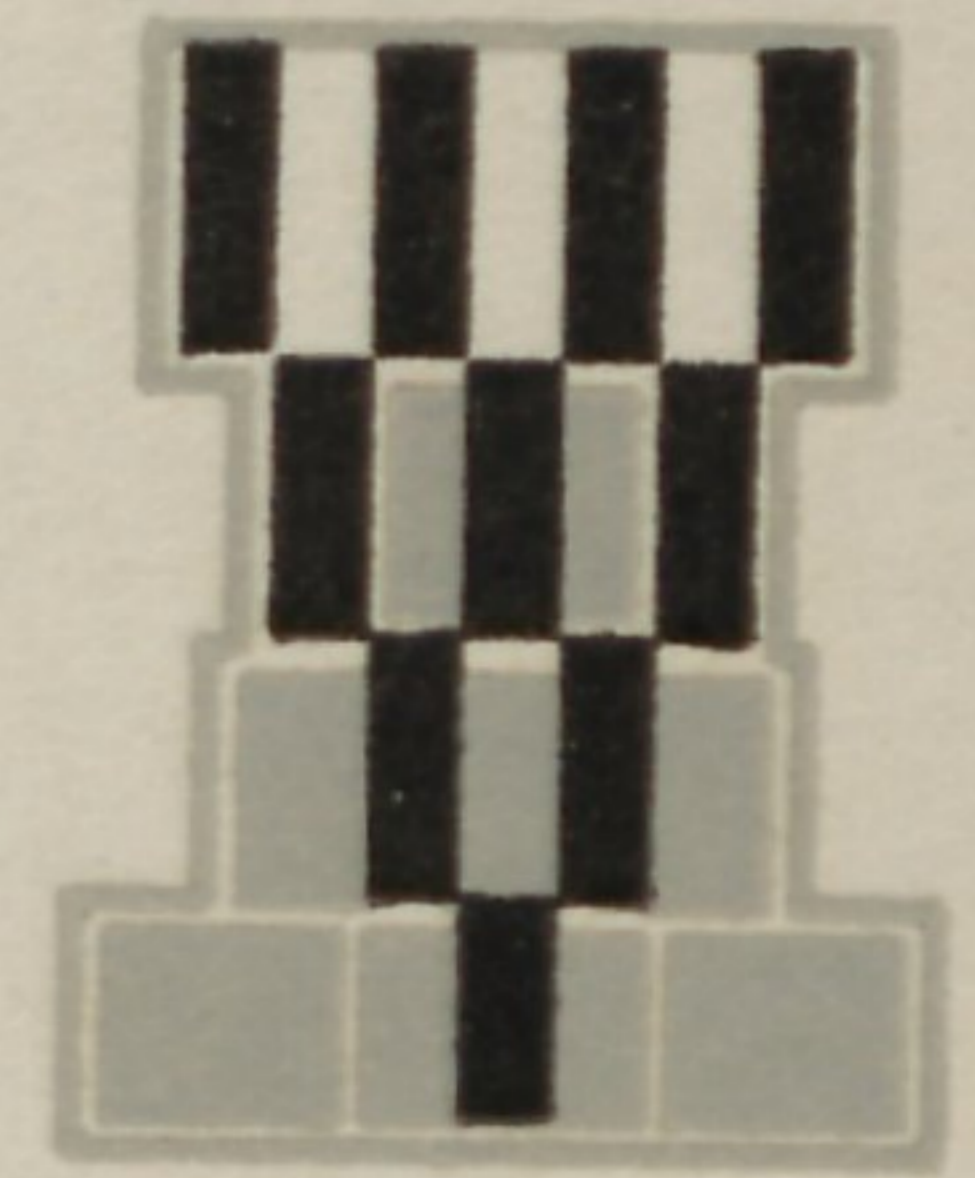

Dear Miss Charles:

I am glad to confirm our conversation of last week regarding the use of your services for the summer of 1933.

We understand that you will be free to sail the last part of May or the first week in June, the exact time to be decided later and that you will return in order to arrive in New York the last week of September - a period of four months.

We expect that you would take certain light responsibilities as a leader on the ocean voyage, that you come directly to Oetz and there would take charge of the drama work as your major job with some emphasis on the dance, music and allied arts on the basis of a memorandum from you which we will discuss within the next week or two.

We also hope to have you become thoroughly informed about plans for drama study ~~and~~ in connection with various drama study groups so that you can eventually supervise such work.

Compensation for these services will be as follows:

1: All traveling expenses, steamer and rail from New York to Oetz and return.

3: Board and room at Oetz and expenses on any trips or excursions undertaken from Oetz with groups.

3: Fee of \$100.

It is understood that the office will keep a record of all persons enrolled through any promotional activities carried on by you in your spare time this Winter and Spring. If the number of students enrolled in this way amounts to ten or more it is understood that we will send you with the drama group in September to the more important points on their itinerary.

As I said to you, we are anxious to have you make the contacts which would come from such travel.


