On 27 February 2001, the Faculty Senate adopted the following resolutions for your consideration:

- 01-10 Summer 2002, Fall 2002, and Spring 2003 University Calendars (attachment 1).
- 01-11 Interpretation related to Appendix D and Unit Personnel Committees (attachment 2).
- 01-12 Interpretation related to Appendix L and new academic units (attachment 2).
- 01-13 Revision to the *2000-2001 University Undergraduate Catalog* (attachment 2).
- 01-14 Three English courses (ENGL 2700, ENGL 2740, ENGL 3750) to receive General Education Humanities credit for the purposes of fulfilling General Education requirements for graduation.
- 01-15 Curriculum matters contained in the 8 February 2001, University Curriculum Committee minutes (attachment 3).

Other items acted upon by the Faculty Senate that do not require your approval are:

- 01-9 Revised Academic Committee Charges.
- 01-16 The Faculty Senate views with alarm the directive to place funds otherwise designated for the State Retirement Plan into a reserve account. The Faculty Senate strongly urges the legislature and the Governor to appropriately fund the State Retirement Plan and not use the funds for other purposes. The Chair of the Faculty is instructed to send this resolution to the appropriate members of the State Legislature and the Governor.
- 01-17 The Faculty Senate expresses concerns with the inadequate funds for the State Health Plan.
