On September 3, 2002, the Faculty Senate adopted the following resolutions for your consideration. A copy of the minutes is attached.

- ✓ 02-25 Curriculum matters contained in the April 25, 2002, University Curriculum Committee minutes (attachment 2).
- ✓ 02-26 Membership on the Enrollment Management Council to include five faculty members to serve as additional members to the Enrollment Management Council. Three faculty members will serve as regular members with vote and will be elected each year by the Faculty Senate. Two faculty members will serve as ex-officio members with vote and will be the Chair of the Admissions and Retention Policies Committee, or designee and the Chair of the Faculty, or designee.
- ✓ 02-27 Resolution reaffirming the commitment of ECU to academic freedom that read as follows:
BE IT RESOLVED that the Faculty of East Carolina University reaffirm the commitment of their university to academic freedom and the fair exchange of ideas as well as their commitment to the understanding of different cultures and values of all kinds with the confidence that thoughtful study and intellectual inquiry are fundamental to this University and the goals of the Faculty.
