REVISED ADMISSION PROCEDURES FOR THE 2003/04 FRESHMAN CLASS
For the admission cycle now underway to admit Fall 2003 students, new policies and procedures have been developed and implemented. There will be four categories of applicant review decisions:

1. Immediate admission into ECU if an applicant falls into one of the two categories below:
a. Rank in the top $1 / 3^{\text {rd }}$ of their high school graduating class \& have an SAT of $1100+$ /ACT of $24+$; or
b. Have a 3.3 unweighted high school GPA, no required minimum SAT/ACT.
2. Applicants who do not meet \#1 above, but are otherwise competitive (e.g. predicted grade point average of 2.5 , or having a SAT of $1000 /$ ACT of 21 and a 3.0 high school GPA), will be placed on a "priority review list." Admission decisions will be communicated to this pool of applicants around December 15, 2002.
3. Applicants who do not meet the minimum criteria in \#2 above will be put on a "waitlist." They will be required to submit any new test scores as well as a fall semester transcript of grades in order to receive a final review. All applicants on the "wait-list" with complete and up-dated files will be informed of an admission decision around February 15, 2003.
4. Applicants who are not competitive will be denied admission.
