 the cut of our Transit opposite page 4 does not rep-
 resent our very latest improvement, the principal of
 this being the placing of the verniers for reading
 the horizontal angle immediately under the
 eyes (N. & S) - instead of on the side between the
 Standards (E & W) as is usual, this does away
 with the walking around the Transit & tripod
 every time a horizontal angle is read & the conse-
 quent liability of shaking the entire instrument -
 It also enables work to be done more rapidly.
