

I send you Willis six papers of powder tied together, a rind and
box. Divide one of the papers of powder equally and give
him half of it immediately mixed with molasses or preserved syrup,
and continue to give him half of one of the papers of powder every
two hours until the fever subsides or until it passes through
his bowels once. If his fever lowers and rises again give the
powders as above until the fever is much lower or until it passes
once through his bowels.

Drop enough from the rind on the cloth in the top of the box
to moisten it (say twenty ~~into~~ fifty drops) and apply it the top of
the box immediately to the back of his neck - It must be pressed
down close to prevent the fumes from escaping and held on
until he complains that it burns him. Apply the box in
this way to two or three different places on the back of his neck
and if his head is not relieved try it on his temples.
If it should not produce a burning sensation in four or five
minutes pour more of the medicine from the rind on the cloth
and apply it again.
