
FOUNDERS WEEK EVENTS SET

Founders Week activities this spring will focus on human health, one ECU's four major areas of emphasis. The week will be celebrated March 22-27 with academic, arts and social events.

Austin Bunch, chief of staff to the chancellor and coordinator of Founders Week, said the activities are designed to celebrate the university's history and its strengths. He said the week also should help point the university community toward ECU's centennial in 2007.

Scheduled activities include:

- A community leaders breakfast and a health care forum on Monday, March 22.
- A student celebration on Tuesday, March 23.
- A military service celebration and a public arts event on March 24.
- The Founders Celebration Convocation, lunch on the mall and Founders Awards Dinner on March 25.
- A Board of Trustees meeting, groundbreaking for the new Learning Village on the health sciences campus, and Founders Week Gala on March 26.

March 8, the actual anniversary of the establishment of the university, will feature a Jarvis Memorial Service and a Founding Fathers walk at Cherry Hill Cemetery in downtown Greenville.

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
