Board of Governors Campus Initiated Tuition and Student Fee Adjustments
For Fiscal Year 2004-2005

Campus Initiated Tuition Changes:

- Campus Initiated Tuition rate was decreased from \$300 to \$225 for In-State students. The proposal was for 3 years, only 1 year was approved. The new schedule for 2004-2005 is included below:

- The Planned use of the funding was modified by the Board of Governors as follows:
 - Not to be used for SPA salary increases
 - To be used to enhance the quality of the academic experience for students, specified as:
 - To reduce the size of classes
 - Increase the number of sections offered especially in core areas where classes must be available to ensure the students graduate on time
 - Hire fewer part-time and more permanent faculty
 - Ensure the competitiveness of faculty salaries
 - Other actions as appropriate

Student Fee Changes:

- Student Activity Fees (SGA, Media, Mendenhall), increase was reduced from \$22 to \$18. The new rate will be \$372.
- Athletics fee increase was reduced from \$20 to \$16. The new rate will be \$336.
