Non-State Funds Trend Analysis

Total revenues for non-state funds have been trending up over the last four years reflecting the positive growth the University is experiencing in the areas of student FTE, grant and research activities, sales and services provided to customers, and patient services.

Increases in non-state funds expenses are in line and reasonable considering the growth the university is experiencing. One exception to this would be the drop in Other Operating expenses from 2001 to 2002 and years since then. This is attributable to the GASB 34 conversion in which the expenditures for capitalized fixed are eliminated. For years prior to 2002, no such elimination was required.
