The University Athletics Committee at its September 29, 2004, meeting voted to recommend that the Faculty Senate join and endorse the Coalition On Intercollegiate Athletics. This is a coalition of faculty senates that is developing guidelines for the shared governance of athletics. It costs no money to join and we aren't committed to any action. The list of faculty senates/councils that have already joined is quite impressive and represents a concerted effort by these senates to develop shared governance processes for athletics. Our endorsement of this coalition sends a message about our shared governance and about our high standards for our athletes.
