bargain and sell unto Esbern Clark of the
County of pitt and State aforesaid a certain tract
or parcel of land lying and being in the State and
County aforesaid on the South Side of Tar River north
Side of Swifts Creek and north side of Creeping Sw
amp bounded as follows Viz Beginning at a water
Oke on the Run of Creeping Swamp James Clark's
Corner and Runs thence North five west with
James Clark's ^{line} James line and with James line
to the said Esbern Clarks own line and with his
own lines to Benjamin Venters line and
with the said Venters lines to Sally Campbell
line and with her lines to the Run of the said
Creeping Swamp and up the various Courses of said
Run to the Beginning laid out by estimation for
three hundred acres be the same more or less to
have and to hold the said bargained premises
together with all wood mines and minerals and all
other appertinances there unto belonging or in any
wise appertaining unto the said Esbern Clark his
heirs and assigns for ever and the said James Campbell
doth oblige him self his heirs Executors administrators and
assigns to warrant and defend the said land and prime
ises unto the said Esbern Clark his heirs Executors ad
ministrators or assigns forever against the
carefull claims of any person whatsoever
