Science magazine, with back issues of Science to 1880, and full access to the News and Collections sections, is now available to ECU users via a campus-wide subscription. Our users have online access to Science and ScienceNOW through the efforts of Joyner and Laupus Libraries. Science has the largest paid circulation of any peer-reviewed general science journal in the world, with an estimated total readership of 1 million. It regularly ranks as one of the most highly-cited journals, as measured by ISI. Science is published by the American Association for the Advancement of Science (AAAS), the world's largest general scientific society.

Science can be accessed from the libraries' home pages using the link for *E-Journal Locator*, and through *SFX Citation Linker* and ECU's SFX "*Find It*" service. Be sure to click on the link for "*Get full text from* … *Publisher's Web Site*." There are over 150,000 articles dating back to the era of the first editor of *Science*, Thomas A. Edison.
