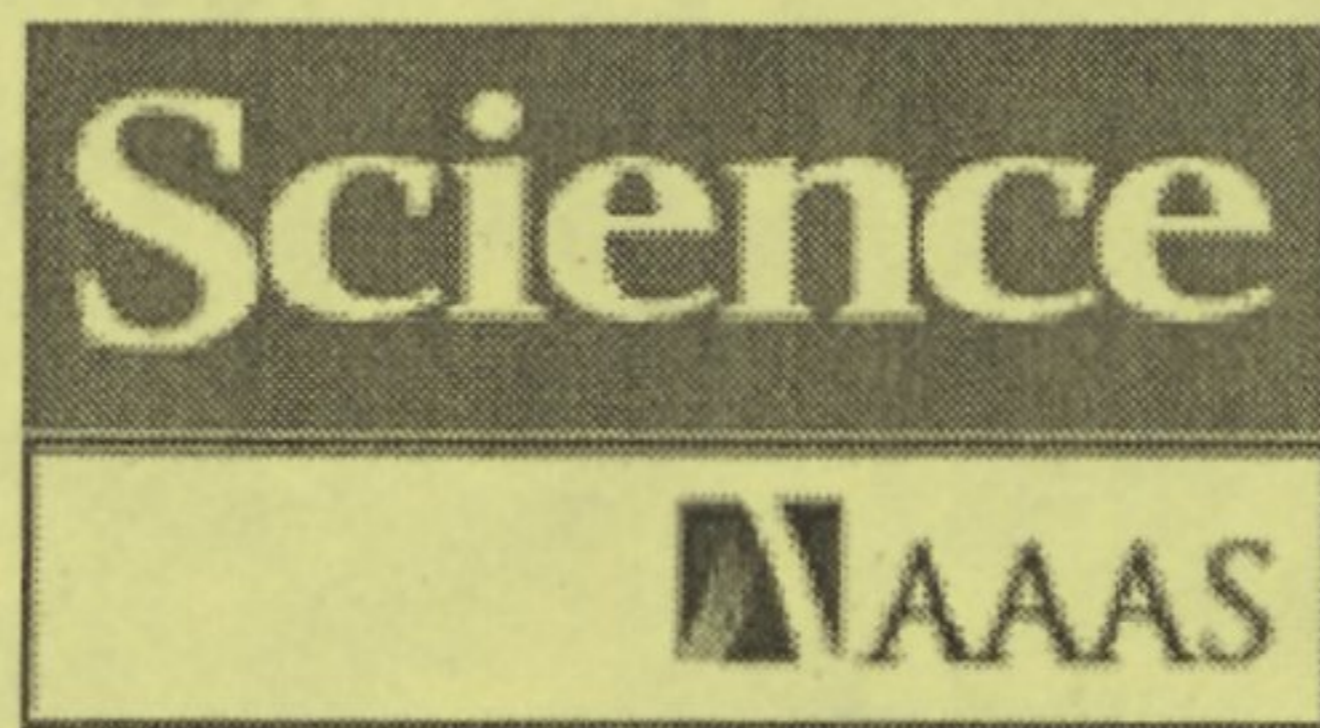

*Science* magazine, with back issues of *Science* to 1880, and full access to the News and Collections sections, is now available to ECU users via a campus-wide subscription. Our users have online access to *Science* and *ScienceNOW* through the efforts of Joyner and Laupus Libraries. *Science* has the largest paid circulation of any peer-reviewed general science journal in the world, with an estimated total readership of 1 million. It regularly ranks as one of the most highly-cited journals, as measured by ISI. *Science* is published by the American Association for the Advancement of Science (AAAS), the world's largest general scientific society.

*Science* can be accessed from the libraries' home pages using the link for *E-Journal Locator*, and through *SFX Citation Linker* and ECU's SFX "*Find It*" service. Be sure to click on the link for "*Get full text from ... Publisher's Web Site.*" There are over 150,000 articles dating back to the era of the first editor of *Science*, Thomas A. Edison.
