Key issues include the perception/reality of differing practices with regard to SPA and EPA personnel matters, the lack of training for chairs, deans, etc., critical attention needed to personnel evaluation (academic citizenship is a key element of handling issues that arise, and training is needed in how to handle difficult situations.
- The results of the recent climate survey were shared (handout) with the identification of five major issues that arose: power and privilege, racial profiling; hostile environment; invisibility of certain groups, and lack of recognition in creating equity
