I just read in the paper that the legislature has granted a 5% salary increase to UNC system faculty. This is not bad at all – unless the raise dollars are distributed as they were last year!

Yes, I'm talking about administrator (including department chairs) raises. Last year's display in both AA and the Arts & Sciences (possibly elsewhere, but I haven't looked at all of the data) was shameful – with chairs and deans getting raises over 10% (many as high as 14%!) while their faculty got much less. I hope there will be a loud voice from and for the faculty that demands that this not happen again this year.
