



A NON-PROFIT CORPORATION

We, the undersigned natural persons of the age of twenty-one years or more, acting as incorporators for the purpose of creating a non-profit corporation under the laws of the State of North Carolina, as contained in Chapter 55A of the General Statutes of North Carolina, entitled "Non-Profit Corporation Act", and the several amendments thereto, do hereby set forth:

1. The name of the corporation is Montford Park Players

- 2. The period of duration of the corporation shall be <u>perpetual</u> (May be perpetual or for a limited period)
- 3. The purposes for which the corporation is organized are: to present plays, particularly those of Shakespeare and any original scripts written locally, for the enjoyment and education of the community and others. It shall be the Montford Park Players' policy to co-operate as fully as possible with other theatre groups and with civic organizations.

* Anyone who has worked on a Montford Park Players' production, or otherwise has worked to further the corporation, in the last twelve months, is a working member. No or minimal charge will be made for either membership or attendance at the performances, but donations will be accepted. All auditions for new plays will be open. No pre-casting will be done. It is the policy of the Montford Park Players that the Show Director shall cast purely on merit and suitability.

4. The corporation is to have the following class or classes of members: (If there are to be no members, so state.) Anyone cast in a production of the Montford Park Players or otherwise working to further the production is automatically a member. Continuing membership is contingent upon continuing availability and actual work in or on a production. No charge will be made for either membership or attendance at the performances, but donations will be accepted.

5. Directors of the corporation shall be elected in the following manner: Board members shall be elected from the membership by majority vote of the membership. There shall be no more than 10 board members and no less than 4.
There shall be no more that 15 board members and no fewer than 4.

9. In addition to the powers granted corporations under the laws of the State of North Carolina, the corporation shall have full power and authority to

- Assume all assets and liabilities of the Association of the Montford Park Players.

- Notwithstanding any other provision of these articles, the Montford Park Players shall not carry on any other activities not permitted to be carried on by (a) an organization exempt from Federal income tax under section 501 (c) (3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1954 or the corresponding provision of any future United States Internal Revenue Law or (b) an organization contributions to which are deductible under section 170 (c) (2) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1954 or any other corresponding provision of any future United States Internal Revenue Law.

- Upon dissolution of the Montford Park Players, its assets except its rights to plays by Richard James, will be given to another theatre group and/or to the Asheville Departemnt of Parks and Recreation if at the time of dissolution, the above named organizations meet the requirement that they themselves must be exempt as organizations described in sections

* 501 (c) (3) and 170 (c) (2) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1954 or any prior or future Internal Revenue Code, 10. or to the Federal, State, or Local government for exclusive public purposes. The Montford Park Players' rights to plays by Richard James will be transferred to an organization and/or an individual designated by Richard James or by an organization and/or an individual designated by Richard James to handle the transference of rights.

- New plays shall be chosen by vote of the members, subject to veto by the Director of the play and the exigencies of casting

- Any member who finds himself unavailable for the next season shall notify the Director of the season as soon as possible. - Full-cast rehearsals will be held on Saturdays and Sundays. Individual or scene rehearsals will be scheduled as necessary.

- Any member unable to attend a scheduled rehearsal must notify the Director of the rehearsal immediately.

- Performance dates for each show will be scheduled by the Board and the Director of the show in consultation with the members involved in the show.

- After a show is in performance, rehearsals will be scheduled as needed by the Director of the show.

- All auditions for new plays will be open. No pre-casting will be done.

-

- Auditions for shows in their second or more season will be open only to cast roles made available by reason of former cast members' unavailability.Former cast members will be given first consideration for their old parts.

ICIES - It is the policy of the Montford Park Players that the Director of all shows shall cast purely on merit and suitability. - In the case of a shortage of backstage workers, all actors will be expected to help with the work necessary for the production. PO - Only a Director of the show or the stage manager designated by the Director as responsible for the production may cancel a **R** The Montford Park Players will perform for schools, hospitals, civic groups, etc., when requested, if members are available for AWS - There will be a party at the end of each seasors for members and their guests. The expense of the party will be borne, when BY possible, by the Montford Park Players, as a gest ure of thanks to the members. 10 - The offices of the Montford Park Players shall be those of the Director(s) of current shows and a Secretary of Public Relations. These offices may serve on the Board of I rectors and shall always serve as consultants to the Board. The Director(s) shall cast, MOVE direct and oversee the production of the 1 y(s). The Secretary of Public Relations shall carry out those duties normally carried out by a Secretary-Treasurer, as well as serve as a public liaison and disseminator of publicity. - The Board of Directors shall handle all financial aspects of the corporation in consultation with the Director(s) and the Secretary - All meetings of the members shall be scheduled to coincide with a regularly scheduled rehearsal, when possible. Notice of all meetings must reach the members, in writing, not less than a week before the meeting and notice must appear in a local newspaper. The members will meet al least twice a war-



ARTICLES OF AMENDMENT TO THE CHARTER OF

MONTFORD PARK PLAYERS, INC.

The undersigned non-profit corporation, for the purpose of amending its articles of incorporation, and in accordance with the provision of Section 55A-36 of the North Carolina Non-Profit Corporation Act, hereby sets forth:

II

Change #4, "The corporation is to have the following class or classes of members" to - "Anyone who has worked on a Montford Park Players' production, or otherwise has worked to further the corporation, in the last thirteen (13) months, is a working member. Other classes may be established by the Board of Directors. No or minimal charge will be made for either membership or attendance at all the performances, but donations will be accepted. All auditions for new plays will be open. No pre-casting will be done. It is the policy of the Montford Park Players that the Show Director shall cast purely on merit and suitability. Continuing membership is contingent upon continuing availability and actual work in or on a production. (CONTINUE ON BACK OF SHEET)
