Dear Dr. Ballard,

On March 29, 2011, the Faculty Senate ranked the University Quality Enhancement Plan (QEP) Topics according to a ranked voting method. Each Senator ranked the topics from 1 to 4. The number of 1st place votes cast for a topic were multiplied by 4; 2nd place votes multiplied by 3; 3rd place votes multiplied by 2; 4th place votes multiplied by 1 and unranked topics received zero points. The topics were then ranked according to the most points.

Below are the votes cast and final ranking of QEP Topics by the Faculty Senate (Resolution #11-29).


