Len Rhodes in IPAR has provided these attached statistics on ECU faculty gender and rank. (see notes from Mr. Rhodes below)

These numbers may be useful in several initiatives.

In 2010 for tenured or tenure track faculty:

21/77 (27%) departments have < 25% female faculty.

32/77 (42%) departments have < 25% of their tenured faculty that are female.

38/77 (49%) departments have no female full professor (9 departments have no male full professor).

11 departments have no tenured female faculty (4 departments have no tenured male faculty).

IPAR is working on getting data from 2007, and these data will be collected in the future as well, so we can monitor the progress of women faculty through the ranks. The stats are broken down by college and department and do not include those with primary administrative appointments (e.g. Chancellor, VCs).

Email from Len Rhodes May 5, 2011:

All:

The data set purposefully does not include fixed-term or teaching instructors. It includes only permanent, full-time, tenured or tenure track, active employees. Note that it excludes those with administrative duties such as our Chancellor or our Deans. The instructor column in the original file sent by Dr. Roper includes only new hires into tenure track positions that are waiting on final award of their PhD or other terminal degree.

The specific selection criteria specified in the report request was:

- I. Instructional Faculty (OACAT = 20, EPA)
- 2. Active (Termination Code =0)
- 3. Permanent Employee (Employment Status = 1)
- 4. Tenure or on track (Tenure status = T or N)
- 5. FT (FTE = 100)
- 6. No ROTC faculty
- 7. No administrators

Note that this was a "first pass" at this report. Undoubtedly, any report such as this raises more questions than it answers. Dr. Roper will work with the committee to determine other specific attributes to include or to modify the selected population to include other faculty.




