sloop. She was in  
the battle of Fort  
Fisher & at Plymouth  
Mo. about Jan/64 or/65  
State these facts  
in Blount's affidavit  
& mention the names  
of the crew he  
will give you  
in the affidavit you  
are to write for him  
in case of Patience  
Moore who really  
don't know on what  
boat Stephen was on  
This will be a great help  
to you.
