Dear Mr. Tapp:-

I was in Raleigh today and conferred with Mr. Brummitt with reference to my claim for work done at Caswell Training School. Mr. Brummitt advised me that he ruled on this matter and placed same in the Governor's hands, and Mr. England, the Governor's private secretary informed me that you had been advised of same.
