Recommendation on Implementation of New Student Perception of Teaching Survey

The current Student Opinion of Instruction Survey (SOIS) would be administered for Fall, 2012 and the Student Perception of Teaching Survey (SPOTS) would be implemented beginning Spring, 2013.

This would serve two purposes:

1. Provides ITCS time to develop the infrastructure for administering the SPOTS;
2. Allows faculty to have a student ratings data from a single instrument for the 2012-13 Faculty Annual Report (since ECU uses Spring 2012 and Fall 2012 student ratings for the 2012-2013 Faculty Annual Report).
