ECU Faculty,

The Committee on Committees and Faculty Senate encourage you to participate in the shared faculty governance of ECU by agreeing to serve as a member of the Graduate Council and/or a University standing academic, appellate, administrative, Board of Trustees, or student union committee. Faculty members currently serving on a University committee or council are to be commended for their dedication to University service.

Volunteer process is simple.

Interested faculty should complete the attached volunteer preference form and forward it to the Faculty Senate office. The deadline for submission of committee/council volunteer preference form is February 15, 2013. Formal committee nominations will be included in the April 23, 2013 Faculty Senate meeting agenda. Formal announcement of committee appointments will be made through the April 23, 2013 minutes and a July 2013 email detailing organizational meetings.

Faculty eligibility requirements for service on University Graduate Council include:

- Holding full graduate faculty status and
- Not serving as a graduate program coordinator.

Faculty eligibility requirements for service on University standing academic committees include:

- Not presently on a committee or serving an expiring 2013 committee term.
 (Members of the Faculty Governance Committee cannot be elected concurrently to an appellate committee.)
- Holding academic rank of instructor, assistant professor, associate professor, or full professor.
 (This excludes fixed term faculty and those on phased retirement.)
- Holding no administrative titles (for service on appellate committees).
 (An administrative title refers to appointment as department chair in a college/school, unit administrator, dean, assistant or associate dean, vice chancellor, assistant or associate vice chancellor, chancellor, assistant or associate chancellor).

Members are elected to staggered three-year terms, which may extend to the beginning of the fall semester; faculty members are generally not elected to more than one academic committee. Service on a single academic or administrative committee is limited to election to two consecutive 3-year terms with ineligibility for election to the same committee for at least one year.
