Faculty Senate Resolution 13-31

The Graduate Curriculum Committee and Undergraduate Curriculum Committee must adhere to both the *University Undergraduate Catalog* and *University Graduate Catalog* definition of 5000-level courses; that is, that all such courses are graduate level courses and must have graduate-level objectives, learning outcomes, and all other graduate school requirements for such courses. No 5000 or higher level courses will require the University Undergraduate Curriculum Committee's approval or undergraduate course requirements

This resolution will be held until after the GCC develops a recommendation to revise the procedure for 5000-level courses.

Formal faculty advice on proposed revisions to the Current Faculty Spousal and Domestic Partner Hiring Standard Operating Procedure

Based on current practice, it is suggested that language be added requiring endorsement of the applicable vice chancellor when a waiver is requested. This step would avoid the possibility of clearing the HR and EEO approval steps only to learn later the division will not support the request. The suggested edit appears in red below.

6. The initiation and continuation of **both** appointments shall be entirely within the purview of the appointing unit(s) in accordance with all applicable personnel policies and procedures. **Special consideration**, or a waiver, for the second

position can be requested, with endorsement of the applicable vice chancellor, from the Department of Human Resources and the Office of Equity and Diversity. No department shall be forced into interviewing or appointing a candidate.
