I am in the process of writing each member of the General Assembly in my troop and apprising the members of the activities of the Patrol and the accidents that occurred in 1972 on a local level. You probably are aware of this information; however, I thought perhaps it might be of interest to you.

I have attached hereto information regarding activities of the Highway Patrol and the accident situation in Pitt and Greene Counties in 1972. You will note that we had 41 persons killed in the two counties that you represent, with over 600 persons injured. During this time, the Patrol in both counties made a total of 7,322 arrests, which included 578 persons that were apprehended for driving under the influence. I hope this information will be of help and assistance to you in any safety legislation that comes before the House.
