Both of the State & county aforesaid. Witnesseth, that I said Holland for & in consideration of the sum of three hundred & twenty nine dollars & Eighty five cents to me in hand paid By said Edgerton the Receipt & payment whereof I do hereby acknowledge myself, fully satisfied content & paid Before the signing & delivery of these presents, have Bargained sold, delivered, given up & conveyed unto said Edgerton his heirs & assigns a certain piece or parcel of land situate lying & being, in the State & county aforesaid, on the North side of Nahonta Swamp & East side of Great Swamp Bounded as follows (viz) Beginning at a dog wood & run N 10 1/4° poles to a pine, then N. 47 1/2° poles to a stake, then N 34 1/2° poles to a Sweet-gum on the run of Great Swamp then down the various courses of the run of said Swamp to two Bays on said Run, then S 64 1/2° poles to a persimmon tree, then S 34 1/2° E 10 1/4° poles to a small post oak, then S 64° W 32 poles to a pine, then S 86° W 88 poles to the Beginning containing ninety four & 1/4 Aers, and I said Holland do By these presents Bind myself my heirs Ex. admr & assigns to warrant & forever defend the right & title of the above described lands unto said Edgerton his heirs & assigns forever free & clear from all charges or incumbrances.
