Dear Sir;

In reply to your letter of May 28 the following are explanations you asked for;

The gifts of the interest in Cozart Eagles & Co. were made August 1, 1936 and I am enclosing statement of this concern to show its worth. The Partners did not receive any salary.

The gift of the National Bank was made January 1, 1936 and the value used is the par value of the stock.

The real estate gift was made July 16, 1936. I bought this property on that date and had it deeded to J.C. Eagles Jr. and F.M. Eagles. The purchase price was \$3813.00 and I immediately put improvements on it to make the cost to me \$4957.84. It has never been deeded in my name and I have never received any income from it.

The firm of Cozart Eagles & Co. is a partnership which operates a Tobacco Warehouse and does not own any real property. The profits are divided among the partners each year and the firm owns just what little equipment is necessary to operate.

Please advise if you desire any further information relative to these matters.
