Subj: Change of duty

1. When directed by the Chief of Naval Operations, Navy Department, on or about 1 December 1950, you will regard yourself detached from duty in Naval Operations, Navy Department, and from such other duty as may have been assigned you; will proceed to the port in which the Commander, Cruiser-Destroyer Force, Pacific Fleet, may be, and upon arrival report to the Commander, Cruiser-Destroyer Force, Pacific Fleet for temporary duty for a period of about four weeks.
2. Upon completion of this temporary duty and when directed by the Commander, Cruiser-Destroyer Force, Pacific Fleet, you will regard yourself detached; will proceed to the port in which the USS ROGERS (DDR-876) may be, and upon arrival report to the commanding officer of that vessel for duty as Executive Officer.
3. You are hereby authorized to delay until 18 December 1950 (provided no excess leave involved) in reporting in compliance with paragraph one of these orders, such delay to count as leave. Keep the Bureau of Naval Personnel advised of your address.
