N. 1132. Know ye that we have granted unto Alexander Hendry  
one hundred acres of land in New Hanover County, Beginning  
at a pine in his own line and running North sixty West one  
hundred poles to a small pine, thence South twenty four West  
one hundred and sixty poles to a Stake, thence South sixty  
East one hundred poles to a Stake in his own line, thence  
with his line to the Beginning. Entered 11<sup>th</sup> August 1874.  
To hold to the said Alexander Hendry his heirs and assi-  
gns forever Dated the 11<sup>th</sup> December 1876.

Beginning at a pine his corner of the old Survey and running with James Hendry's line South forty seven West seventy four poles to a small pine his corner, thence with his line South six East one hundred and forty poles to a stake in his other line, thence with said East thirty poles to his old corner, thence his line to the Beginning Entered 19<sup>th</sup> September 1815. To Hold to the said Alexander Hendry his Heirs and assigns forever Dated 11<sup>th</sup> day of December 1816.
