with his line to the Beginning. Entered 11th August 1874.

gns forever Dated the 11th December 1876.

Beginning at a pine his corner of the old Survey and running with James Hendry's line South forty seven West seventy four poles to a small pine his corner, thence with his line South six East one hundred and forty poles to a Stake in his other line, thence with said East thirty poles to his old corner, thence his line to the Beginning Entered 19th September 1815. To Hold to the said Alexander Hendry his Heirs and assigns forever Dated 11th day of December 1816.
