WHEREAS, Blommt Bro has agreed to make advances to Newsom Norsley for the purpose of enabling said Newsom Norsley to cultivate the lands hereinafter described, during the year 1909, the amount of said advances not to exceed Three Hundred Thirty Dollars.

AND WHEREAS, said Newsom Norsley is indebted to said Blommt Bro in the further sum of Five Hundred Sixty Four and 01/100 Dollars now due. *for which they hold my note.*

NOW, THEREFORE, in order to secure the payment of the same, the said Newsom Norsley do hereby convey to said Blommt Bro

all the crops of every description which may be raised during the year 1909 on the following lands in Pitt County, North Carolina Bethel Township, adjoining the lands of Jerry James J S L Ward J H Bryan Others

and also the following other property, viz: One yellow Mule about 10 years old. One Black Mule about 8 yrs old. One Black or dark Bay Horse 13 yrs old. 3 carts wheels and axles. One Top Buggy and all farming utensils of every description.

And if by the first day of ~~October~~ Nov 1909, said Newsom Norsley fails to pay said indebtedness, then said Blommt Bro may close this lien, as provided in section eighteen hundred of the Code, or otherwise, and may sell said crops and other property after TEN DAYS' NOTICE, posted at the Court House door and three other public places in said county, and apply the proceeds to the payment of said indebtedness and all costs and expenses of executing this conveyance, and pay the surplus to said Newsom Norsley.

And the said Newsom Norsley represents that said crops and other property are the absolute property of his own and free from incumbrance.

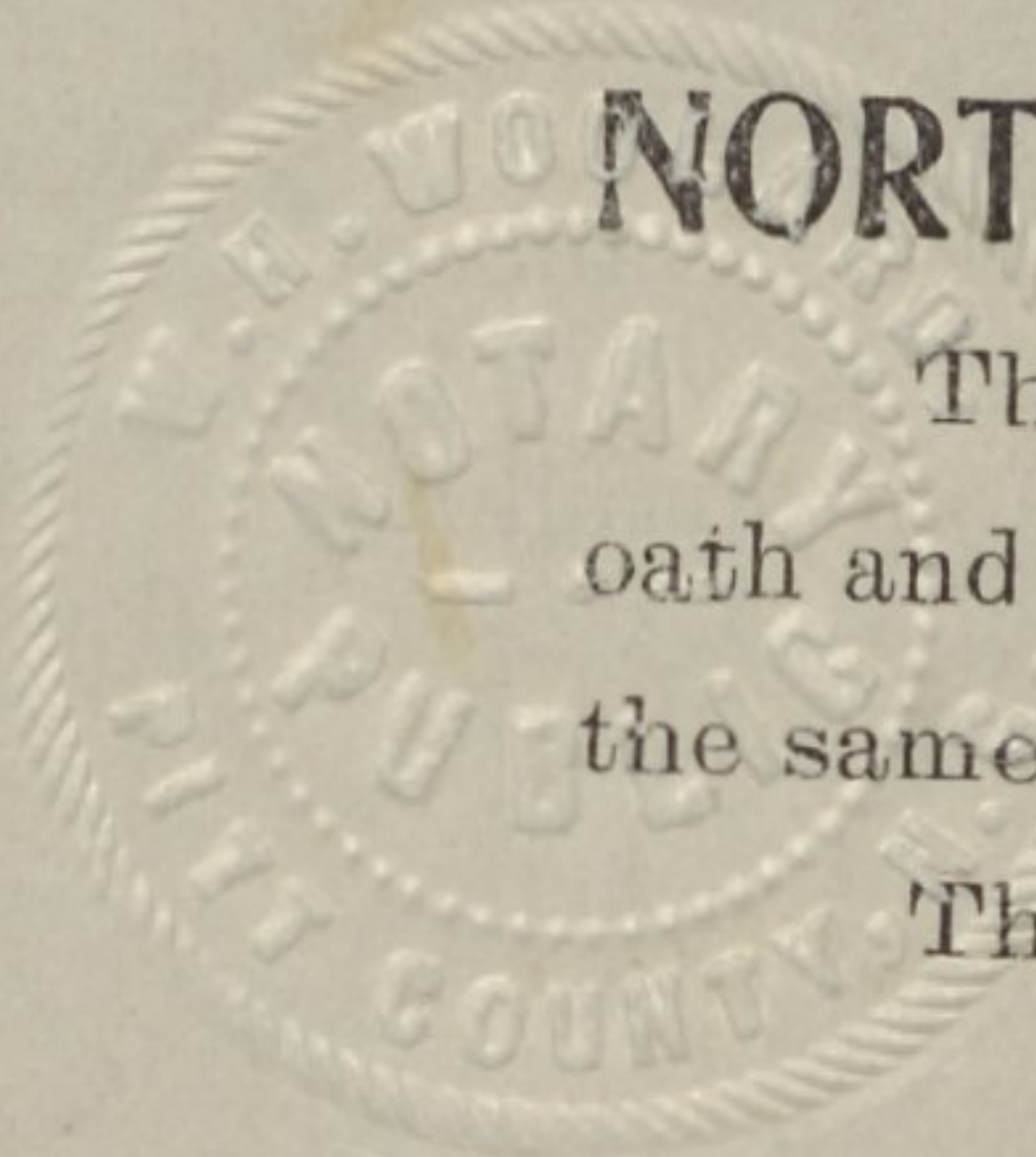
