- 0400 - Call the cook.
- 0445 - Call the Master At Arms and leading Division Petty Officers.
- 0500 - Reveille.
- 0526 - General Quarters.
- 0626 - Sunrise. Light ship. Secure from General Quarters.
- 0700 - Breakfast.
- 0815 - Muster on stations. Division Officers submit report of absentees to Ship's Office prior to 0900.
Turn to - ship's work.
Air all bedding - weather permitting.
- 1130 - Dinner for 1200-1600 watch.
- 1145 - Dinner.
- 1300 - ROPE YARN SUNDAY.
- 1330 - The following movie will be shown in the crew's mess hall.
"CORSICAN BROTHERS" with Douglas Fairbanks, Jr., Ruth Warrior, and Akim Timoroff.
- 1600 - Clean sweepdown - all decks.
- 1700 - Supper.
- 1823 - Sunset. Darken ship. General Quarters.
- 1920 - Muster all 8 o'clock reports.
