THIS INSTRUMENT made this 29th day of November, 1919,
by Richard A. Parker, of the first part, to T. W. Mewborn, Commissioner, of the
second part, WITNESSETH:

THAT WHEREAS the second party has conveyed a tract of
land to the first party, and the first party has executed a mortgage to the
second party for a portion of the purchase price thereon, and whereas the notes
secured by the mortgage do not draw interest except from the first day of Jan-
uary, 1920, all of said instruments being of this date, the same are referred
to to make this instrument clear and specific.

It is now understood and agreed that the said first
party will continue to pay rent at the same rate as is now provided for for
the said house and lot herein mentioned unto the second party for the benefit
of the life tenant, Mrs. W. E. Mewborn, from the date of the deed to the
first day of January, 1920.
