It's a darn good pipe and I smoke it about once or twice a day. I don't want to smoke it too much because it doesn't do a guy too much to smoke.

Well how have you been since I asked you yesterday? I am feeling alright but get a little lousy once in a while but I get over it in a hurry. This letter will be short because I just wrote you yesterday.

I can't wait until I get home to take you out and walk around Rochester again. You will have to show me the town all over again because I might get lost if you are not with me.

Have they changed any of the shows since I have left? By that I mean the inside of the theatre. Have they

decorated it a little different or anything like that? I haven't been in the Louvre or Palace in a long while and am wondering if it still is the same on the inside.

Are you going up town to see that Japs but or don't you feel like seeing things like that? It would be a nice thing to see and you can see what we are fighting against. Is it very hot at night or does it get cool at night?

What I want to go to when I get home is to concerts that they have in the parks at night. That is I'll go to see them if it is the time for them. I hope I get home that time of the year for them but if I don't I'm just out of luck.

We'll write again soon and I hope its real soon. What do you do during the day? Do you lay around in the sitting on the front porch all day or do you work a little?
