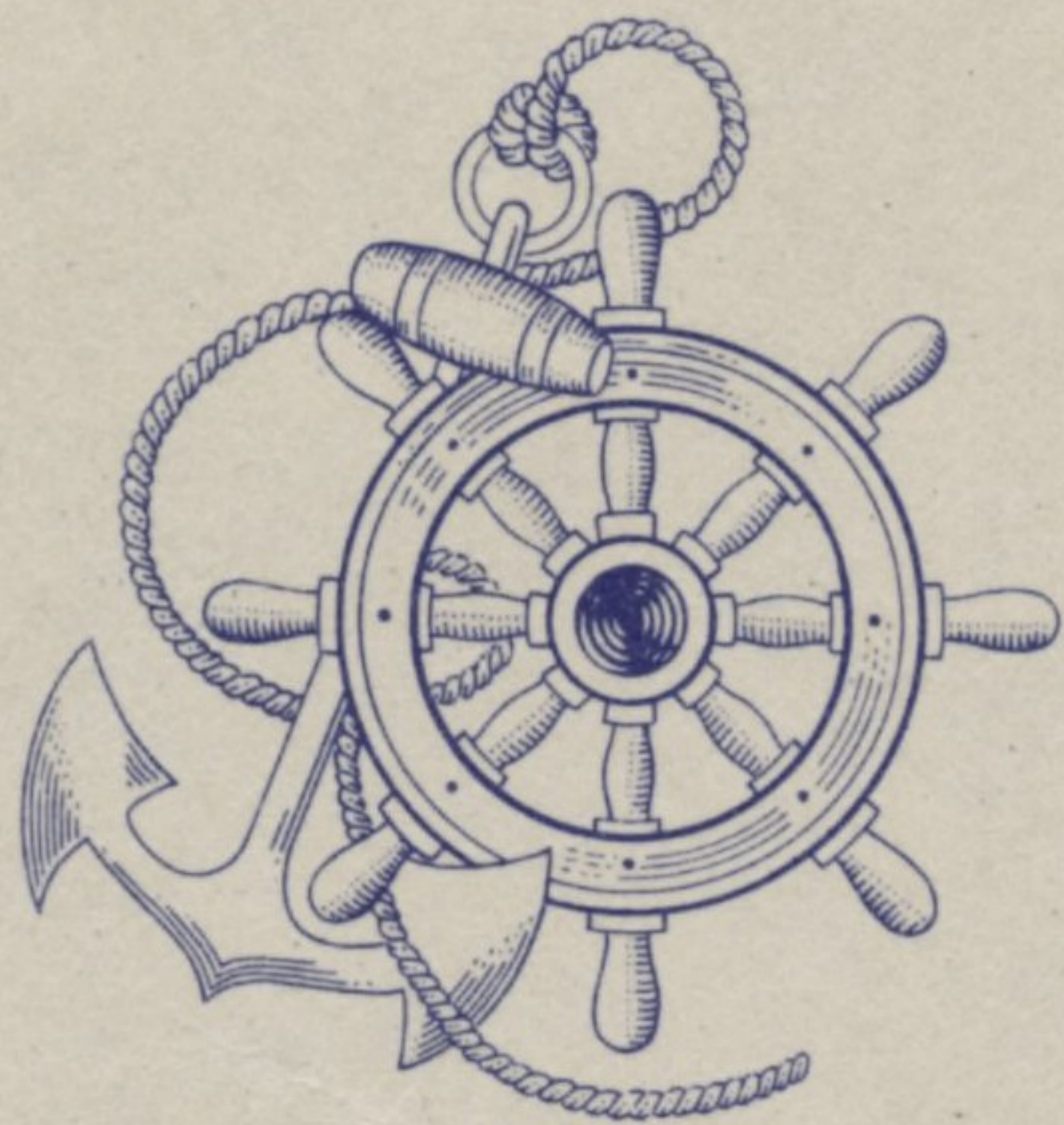

Dear folks:

Got your letter today with the paper clippings. Anita already sent them to me yesterday so it wasn't anything new. So sorry?

Jack Powell got here about a week ~~more~~ ^{earlier} than we did. He lives close to us though and we see him almost every day. He will probably pull out a week or less before we do. We've made our plans for coming home but haven't had them verified as yet so I'm not planning on too much before it actually comes thru.

Tell Nadeen I haven't had time to answer her letters as it's about all I can do to get a letter off to you every day. They're racking down on us and we're not given as much time as we were before.

Sue made Service School down here as you can tell by the stationery and will probably be sent back to Great Lakes to go to this school. That would mean liberty every week-end and Sid had a chance to come home.

They are shipping the men across now in 10 weeks training unless they are going to school. If I go to school it would probably be six months before Sid go across.

I'm sending a couple more pictures in this letter even if they aren't much good. Can't expect much you know. You don't get anymore than you put in to them. Better arrange for a family picture when I'm home on leave.

Have to close for now as we're a class in 15 minutes. Have to write a couple letters yet. Will write again soon.
