A brass plaque will be attached to the pole inscribed with his name as well as yours, such as:

"Given in memory of Lt. Nathanial Ashby, 3rd Virginia Regiment by Robert L. Rogers 1988".

The cost of the flags will range in price from \$150.00 - \$450.00. If you are interested, please give me the name of the regiment or state in which your propositus served, and I will be able to give you specifics as to flag choices and costs. My address is 95 Gray Fox Run, Pinehurst, N.C. 28374.
